

Visit Bågø Nature Center

In the village located in the very centre of the island lies Bågø Nature Center. The former teacher's house and school was rebuilt to accommodate and facilitate up to 48 persons at a time.

At the nature center you can rent a room with tea kitchen and bathroom with shower/WC. You will have at your disposal equipment for catching and studying wildlife on the island, and you can book a nature guide at assens.dk/naturcenter

The nature center has a permanent exhibition about the nature of the island, and all footpaths of the island start here.

Bring Along Your Mobile Phone

If you bring along your mobile phone, you can scan the QR codes and get access to lots of information about the fascinating history and nature of the island.

Bågø Nature Center has free access to WiFi and you can download a free QR code reader from Apple Store or Android market.

Welcome to the Bågø Paths

Bågø is the obvious destination for a day trip. A cycling or walking tour round about the island offers wonderful nature experiences.

On Bågø you will find four marked routes all starting at the nature center in the middle of the island. The paths lead you through the beautiful landscapes of the island.

There are plenty of opportunities for a rest at one of the resting areas and you can enjoy the view from the birdwatching blinds.

Along the paths, info signs are set up with information on the local nature and the culture-historical values.

On the map of Bågø you can see four routes, and these are also marked in the landscape with yellow, blue, green and red triangles on poles. The numbers on the map indicate info points.



Practical Information

Bågø is situated west of Assens. A ferry departs from Assens harbour and the crossing time is 29 minutes (see departure times at www.baagoe.info)

At the harbour of Bågø you will find toilets, kiosk, camping site and renting of bikes.

Please remember that you are a guest on the island.

The paths are open for foot traffic only. They are partly trample paths and therefore the passage may be influenced by the season and vegetation.

Walking-impaired and families with prams should use the roads.
